1. Qualitative And Quantitative Up gradation Of Library As Well As Promotion Of Virtual Learning

Objectives:

- ✓ To provide remote access to a variety of national and international content.
- ✓ To inculcate the habit of reading among children as well as to provide documents to supplement teaching and learning.
- ✓ To collect, organize and collate print and digital information and Disseminate at the point of care and for future.

Context:

Library plays a crucial role in college education and virtual learning by providing access to a vast array of resources including books, journals, data bases and multimedia materials. They serve as hubs for research, study and collaboration, Offering students and faculty a quiet space to concentrate and engage with information. Libraries are indispensable in facility the acquisition of knowledge and fastening academic success in both traditional and online learning environment.

Practice:

In qualitative and quantitative up gradation of library our college has provided Wi-Fi facility in library and maintained a full setup for reading for girls as well as boys. Special reading room has been provided to students. In library a special and separate setup for teachers is maintained. Each year a large number of books (text books as well as competitive books, magazines) are added to library. Library development committee meets every year to make improvements in library. College has subscribe to various e-journals, e-shodh sindhu, Shodhganga membership, e-books, Databases, N-list/INFLIBNET and large number of CDs and DVDs of educational content. College has set up E-resource centre within library with 8 computers equipped with Wi-Fi, internet facility.

Problems faced:

Being a small college generation of funds is the biggest problem encountered us. Training the staff to cop up with installation of software as well as operating the system was another problem.

Despite of having a girl college in neighborhood number of girl student has increased year by year in our college. This has lower down the drop out ratio of students.
