The college's main goal is to impart education to improve society. Students of college take part enthusiastically in zonal, university, district, state and college level academic activities. As DAV College, Pundri is surrounded by many villages, so students which come from these rural areas get a chance to learn basic knowledge of how to groom them academically as well as personally.

As these students get admission to attain professional success in their future, so the distinctive part of an educational institution should imparting education as it remains an important benchmark factor for institutional achievement, so the main objective of college here is the satisfaction of students. Thus the College focuses on cultivating students' curiosity, interest, optimism, and passion for learning both within and outside of the classroom. Furthermore, the institution is devoted to increase student participation to guarantee that students obtain the necessary skills and competencies to build their physical, social, and emotional skills. Students participate in co-curricular and extension activities such as sports, quizzes, speeches/debate, poster making, slogan/essay writing competitions and cultural events, which are often conducted at the college and university level. NSS unit of the college conducts activities like Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao and Swachhta Abhiyan which helps our students in understanding the value of these initiatives in bringing change in the society. NSS one day camp teaches students to work in collaboration with others and to understand the importance of unity. Seven days camp of NSS teaches students to develop a civic and social responsibility skill. It teaches them to understand their position in society and its needs. These day-night camps boost students' self-esteem, sense of responsibility, and empathy for others' needs. The value of green initiative also get recognition and motivation by IQAC every year and execution of various initiatives like drives for Tree plantation, Say No to Plastic and Cleanliness Drives get place in college's every year plan.
